## Your Cruising Area

Whangaroa to Bay of Islands to Whangaruru.  
See marked area on boat charts. This could be extended by negotiation for wider cruising and Game fishing depending upon experience

## Your Experience

You will need to be fully competent at general boat handling, anchoring, reading charts and have good basic seamanship skills. Minimum age for a skipper is 25 years (exceptions for qualifications). Vessels 10m and over require two experienced persons. If you doubt your ability – discuss your needs with our staff. An hour boat orientation is included prior to you leaving.

### Your Options

**Bareboat:** You skipper, your friends/ family crew.  
**Skippered:** We skipper, you crew .... Or a crew can be provided.  
**Tuition:** Our qualified instructor provides on board orientation before you leave.

## ONBOARD YOUR VESSEL:

**Navigation and safety equipment:** Local charts, Parallel Rule / Dividers. Life Jackets, Life Rings, Flares, Fire Extinguishers, EPIRB, First Aid Kit, VHF Radio, Fog horn, Flashlight and a Compass are provided on the boat.

**Galley Equipment:** All necessary cooking utensils, crockery and cutlery can be found on the boat. Two tea towels, rubbish bags, paper towel, start pack tea, coffee, sugar are provided. All boats have teapots and coffee plungers. Also two Hand towels, salt and pepper.

**Cleaning Equipment:** Buckets, cloths, brushes, detergents and other cleaning products are provided on the boat.

**General Equipment:** The following can also be found onboard: AM/FM Stereo radio, Log, Swim platform / ladder, Anchors, Depth finder, Boat hook, Mooring Lines, Dinghy & oars, Tool Kit, Pillows, Fish Knife / Board and Toilet Paper. Most of the boats have either a CD or Tape Player and cigarette lighters suitable for recharging mobile phones.
